BTEC National Extended Diploma in Sport

The BTEC National Extended Diploma in Sport is equivalent to three A Levels and is a challenging and exciting course.

All aspects of Football are studied, including match analysis, strength and conditioning and individual mentoring.

The course provides students with opportunities to carry out practical work and develop skills as well as studying theory.

There are regular visits to St Georges Park; the English Football Association's national football centre for coaching, to participate in sessions with PFA members.

As part of the two year programme, students have the opportunity to acquire a number of additional national governing body qualifications including:

- Emergency First Aid in a sport setting
- FA Referee Course
- Level 2 Personal Training
- Swimming Instructors Course

All students receive comprehensive fitness related programmes and nutritional guidelines from trained professionals and have access to qualified sports therapists.

The facilities at Thomas Telford are second to none. The Football Academy players have access to a floodlit grass pitch maintained to the highest standard. There is also a full size floodlit 3G astro turf pitch to train and play matches.

There is a state of the art Fitness Centre led by professionals which has the very latest fitness training equipment by Technogym. Student's fitness progression is tracked, monitored and reported on using the Technogym Wellness system. There is also a comprehensive free weight training area.

Students also have access to a 25 metre swimming pool.
