The Cambridge Technical Extended Diploma Performing Arts is equivalent to three A Levels and covers a wide range of triple threat specialisms, including:

- Acting technique and performing skills
- Singing technique and performing skills
- Dance technique and performing skills
- Influential performance practice
- Performing repertoire
- Devising for original performance
- Classical theatre performance
- Arts administration
- Preparing proposals for commissioning briefs
- Preparing to work in the Performing Arts industry

The emphasis of this course is to develop skills in all areas of musical theatre so that students become all round performers. There are also opportunities to develop skills in technical theatre.

The School has strong links with local performing arts organisations that are able to enrich the students' experience.
