Intent

The intention of BTEC Health and Social Care is to ensure that each student has the opportunity to understand the wide range of opportunities within the field, as well as preparing students for future employment. The Health and Social Care course is a vocational qualification which takes an engaging, practical and inspiring approach to learning and assessment. The course equips students with a sound, specialist and realistic understanding of how to meet the needs of individuals using services and specialist equipment, whilst challenging stereotypes and discrimination. The study of care values is at the heart of Health and Social Care which develops skills such as empathy, compassion, commitment, tolerance and empowerment. At **Level 3**, the BTEC Extended Certificate and Diploma in Health and Social Care (2016) offer a comprehensive exploration of the field. Units cover human growth and development, working in health and social care, and meeting individual care and support needs. Students also delve into psychological and sociological perspectives, health education, and practical applications, preparing them for higher education and professional careers.

We employ a variety of teaching strategies, including online curriculum resources, interactive textbooks, and digital learning platforms like ActiveLearn. These tools support a blended learning approach, allowing students to reinforce their knowledge and skills both in and out of the classroom. Regular assessments, including recall tests, end-of-topic evaluations, and mock exams, ensure that students are well-prepared for formal assessments and can track their progress effectively
