You organise each of these yourselves


You must have an assessor for each section who will write a report for you once you have completed it

Examples


- Help at your local sports team

Examples


- Attending the fitness centre



 - Compass















Behaviour expectations

- The behaviour when attending the Session 3's, training days and expeditions are the same expectations as when you are in School.
- If there are behaviour concerns the normal School protocol will be followed.
- If we feel your child is not ready to take part in the expedition after receiving the training, your child will be asked to defer until the following year, when again this will be assessed.



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A letter will be going home with instructions of how to make the £100 deposit to secure your place. The final balance of £105 will be due at the end of October.

There are two programmes, A and B. You will be placed in one of these groups.

The groups are exactly the same, they just run over two different sets of dates. Please check you can do all of the dates. If there is one programme you cannot do, please ask your parents to state it in the Parent Pay additional notes section
