




So, how does the Expedition differ from the previous level?









We build on what was taught at the previous level, refine key skills and prepare for a longer duration away.





At EDGE-ucation we believe in using a remote and wild environment, this brings greater responsibility and independence but also, it's a far more enjoyable and rewarding experience.














Getting to the Expedition Area







Please be aware, EDGE-ucation are not responsible for travel to the expedition areas.


Using the train is only a suggestion that we have found works well.


