Family contract for Internet Safety

I WILL...

1. Tell my parents about people I meet online. I know adults may pretend to be children sometimes to get children to talk to them.
2. Tell my parents right away if someone sends me any pictures or e-mails that make me uncomfortable.
3. Tell my parents if someone online asks me to do something I am not supposed to do.
4. Talk to my parents about rules for using the Internet, and I will follow them. We will decide about the time of day I can be online, how long I can be online, and the places on the Web that are OK for me to visit.
5. Be a good online citizen and not do anything that hurts other people or is against the law.

I WILL...

1. Not give out my address, phone number, school name or address, parents' names, or any other personal information to anyone I meet on the Internet.
2. Not telephone anyone I meet online without asking my parents first.
3. Not e-mail pictures of myself to anyone I do not know.
4. Not buy or order anything online without asking my parents for permission first.
5. Not fill out any form online that asks me for information about my family or myself without asking my parents for permission.
6. Not answer any e-mails or messages from someone I do not know.
7. Not agree to get together with someone I meet online.
