### **Activity**


Produce a game or activity which would teach others about you.

- ✓ At least 8 different facts




Make sure you consider:

Produce a painting or drawing of something you are interested in o r even a self portrait.








Produce a 3d model using materials you have to hand which will tell the viewer something about you.

Think about using carboard, tissue, pipe cleaners, recycled materials etc (anything you can find at home)

- ✓ Rhyming
- ✓ Different verse structure
- ✓ Technical vocabulary if you can
- ✓ Perform it if possible
- ✓ If written, think about font and presentation
- ✓ You could illustrate around the poem to finish off



Make sure you consider:


- ✓ Being clear with your information

- ✓ Be confident and engaging





This one is really open for you to be creative. This could be...


- ✓ Jigsaw
