Dance	<p>Bob Fosse</p> <p>Dance is split into 2 subsections: Performing & Evaluating.</p> <p>Performing: Who is Bob Fosse? What are the key features of Fosse's style? What is the history of Jazz? How did Bob Fosse develop the world of Jazz?</p> <p><i>Students will develop on their Jazz technique skills from Year 9 alongside developing their knowledge of the Jazz dance style. Students will develop their confidence with regular performances in front of peers to prepare them for their exam performance.</i></p> <p>Evaluating: Students will use independent study to reflect upon their rehearsals and log the outcomes on a rehearsal log.
