	<p>Explore Students will explore a variety of scripts to develop their performance skills and rehearsal technique.</p> <p>Rehearse Students will rehearse a scene from a play, developing their skills for a specific style of theatre.</p> <p>Perform Students will perform the script they have rehearsed with appropriate costume, props and lighting to show appropriate performance skills specific to the style.</p> <p>Review Students will review their rehearsal process by logging their development at key stages of rehearsals.</p> <p>Evaluate</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will need to rehearse their lines as homework.
