All students are provided with an individual login to this website in September.</p> <p>In addition, www.langugaenut.com will be used weekly for examination skills practice in listening and reading across each of the key themes.</p> <p>We recommend BBC Bitesize for revision of exam skills and grammar. GCSE French - Edexcel (for exams until 2025) - BBC Bitesize</p> <p>As students prepare for their speaking examination, they must be reciting and memorising key questions, vocabulary and answers at home. A “little and often” approach works best for language learning and so 5-10 minutes a night is recommended.</p> <p>MS Teams is used to communicate with students and share resources.</p> <p>All lesson resources can be found on the TTS OLC.</p>
