Prior to the pandemic, our Performing Arts department raised money for the Badarpur Water Project in our Singing Showcase which contributed to the set up and maintenance of two electrically powered water filtration plants. Badarpur is a village in the south of

Bangladesh and is home to around 400 people; the Badarpur Water Project - founded by ex-TTS student Joshua Taylor - was created to supply the region with clean water to support hygeine, sustain sanitation and save lives as a result. Due to the pandemic, the project has taken a lot longer to complete but it was unveiled for the public to use a few

weeks ago and is now supplying clean

water to the community!
