Wrekin Walk FAQ

What if my child cannot take part in the walk but will attend school?

Students will be in a supervised session where they will work on a set Employability and Enterprise project.

How can my child get access to water?

Students are asked to bring water with them along with a packed lunch. Bottled water will be available to purchase at the bottom of the Wrekin and there will be a bottle refill station along the route.

What if my child cannot complete the full walk?

There will be marshals along the walk checking on student progress and minibuses available to return students to school should they need to.

What if my child feels unwell?

First aiders will be available on call across the route and minibuses will be available to return students to school should they need to.

Can my child access the toilet during the walk?

We have hired toilet facilities at the bottom of the Wrekin

What should my child wear?

All students should be in their Thomas Telford school PE kit. They should all wear good, strong trainers and thick socks suitable for walking. <u>Students should be dressed appropriate for the weather and wear a hat and sun cream in the event of a warm day.</u>

What if there is bad weather?

We will monitor the weather closely. In the event of a warm day, students should have sun cream and a sun hat.

If it is raining, the walk will continue, and students need a suitable coat.

Who will my child walk with?

Students are split into their houses and will walk in groups with a member of staff.
