- Thank you for attending the first Session 3 of the Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Award
- You will now be registered to eDofE which is website where you will have a personal user area and you will log each of your sections
- At your next session 3 you will get your username and password and we will log on and go through eDofE and what is required
- Once you have logged on you will fill in your personal details and your D of E welcome pack will be posted to your house
- You can now start the three sections Volunteering, Skill and Physical. You are insured under Duke of Edinburgh
- This is your responsibility and personal to you. However if you are struggling then please speak to Mrs Price and she can give you some ideas.
- You can back date your sections up to 3 months so if you have been doing any of your sections previously it can be used

Examples

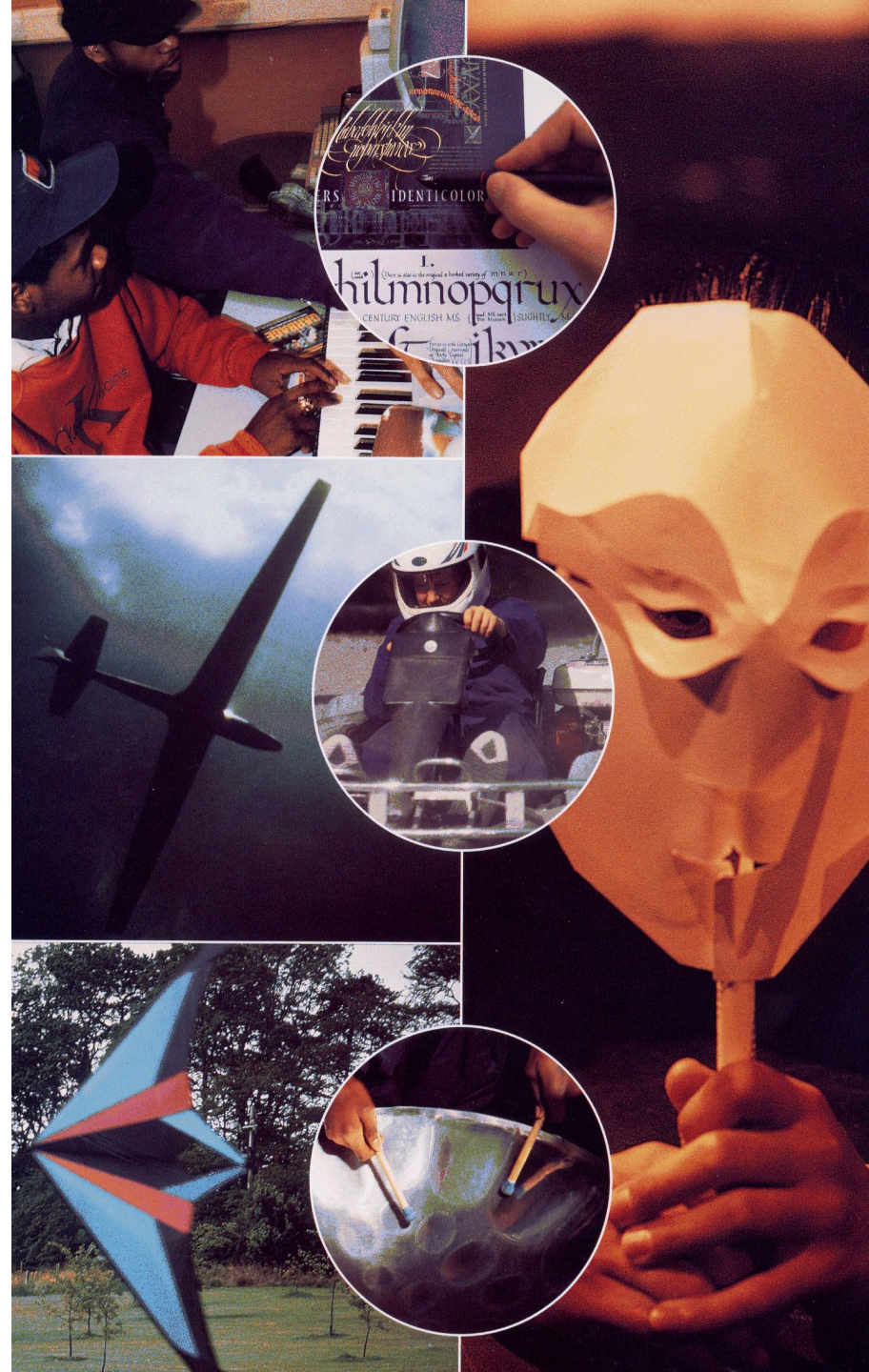
- Help at your local sports team with a younger age group

Examples

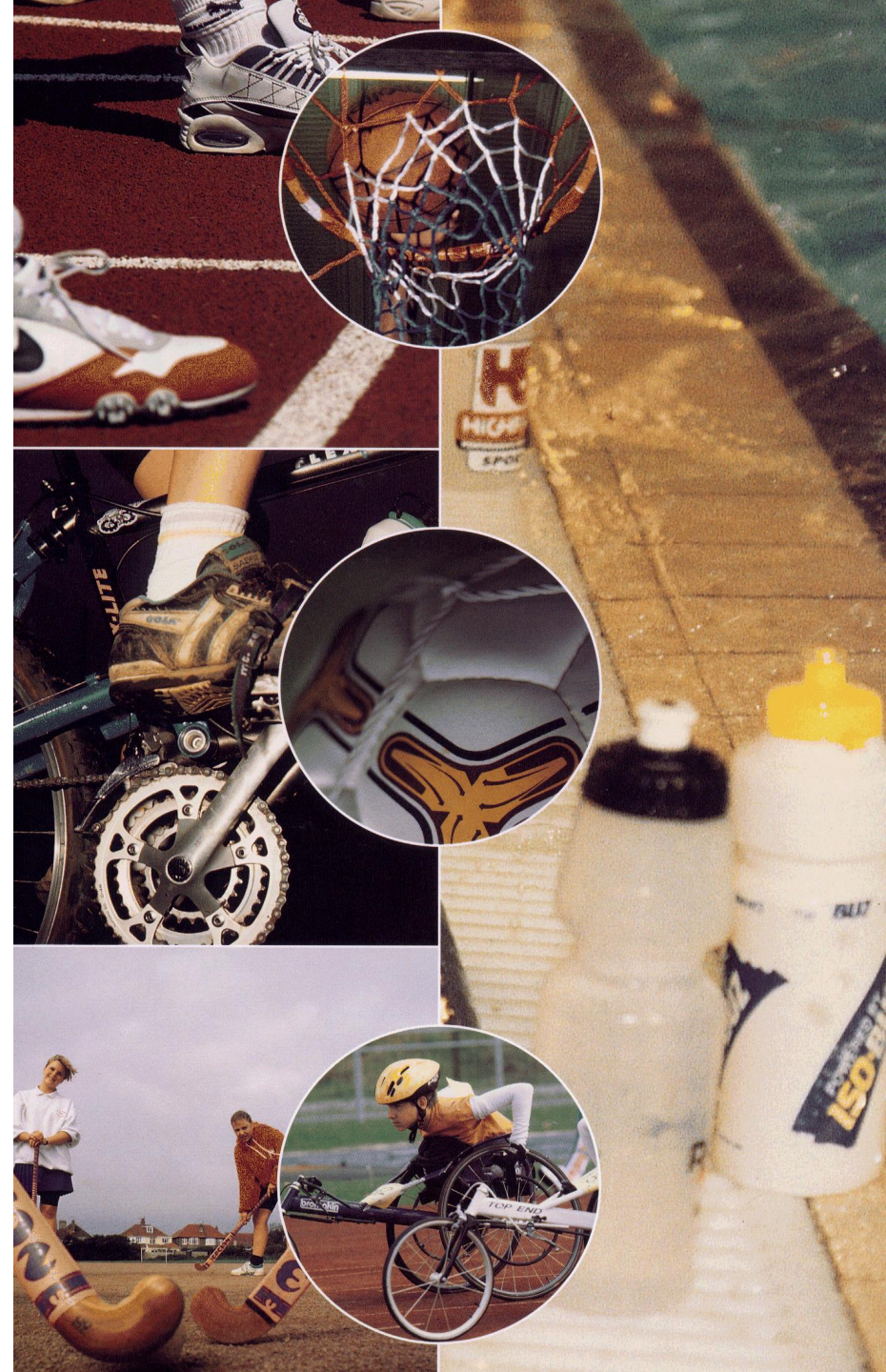
- Learning to play an instrument
- Cooking/baking each week
- Officiating
- Writing movie reviews each week
- Writing sports review each week



Physical

Examples

- Attending the fitness centre
- Playing for you local sports club outside school
- Playing for a School sports team
- Completing a run/walk each week aiming to improve your distance

There is also an e|DofE app on your phones/tablets that you can use to log what you are doing and to upload your assessor reports

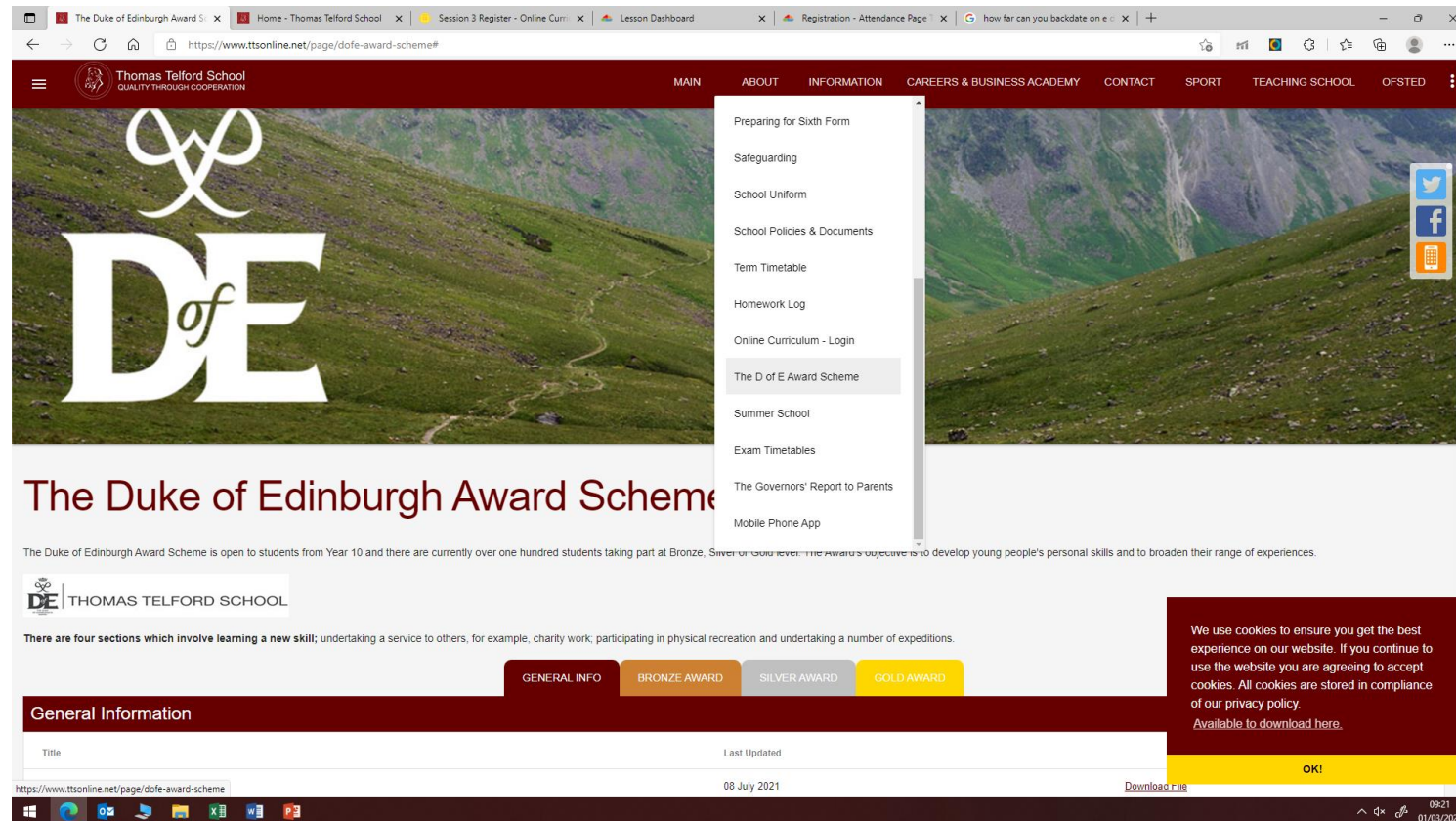


Bronze Award

- All other kit will be provided by the School

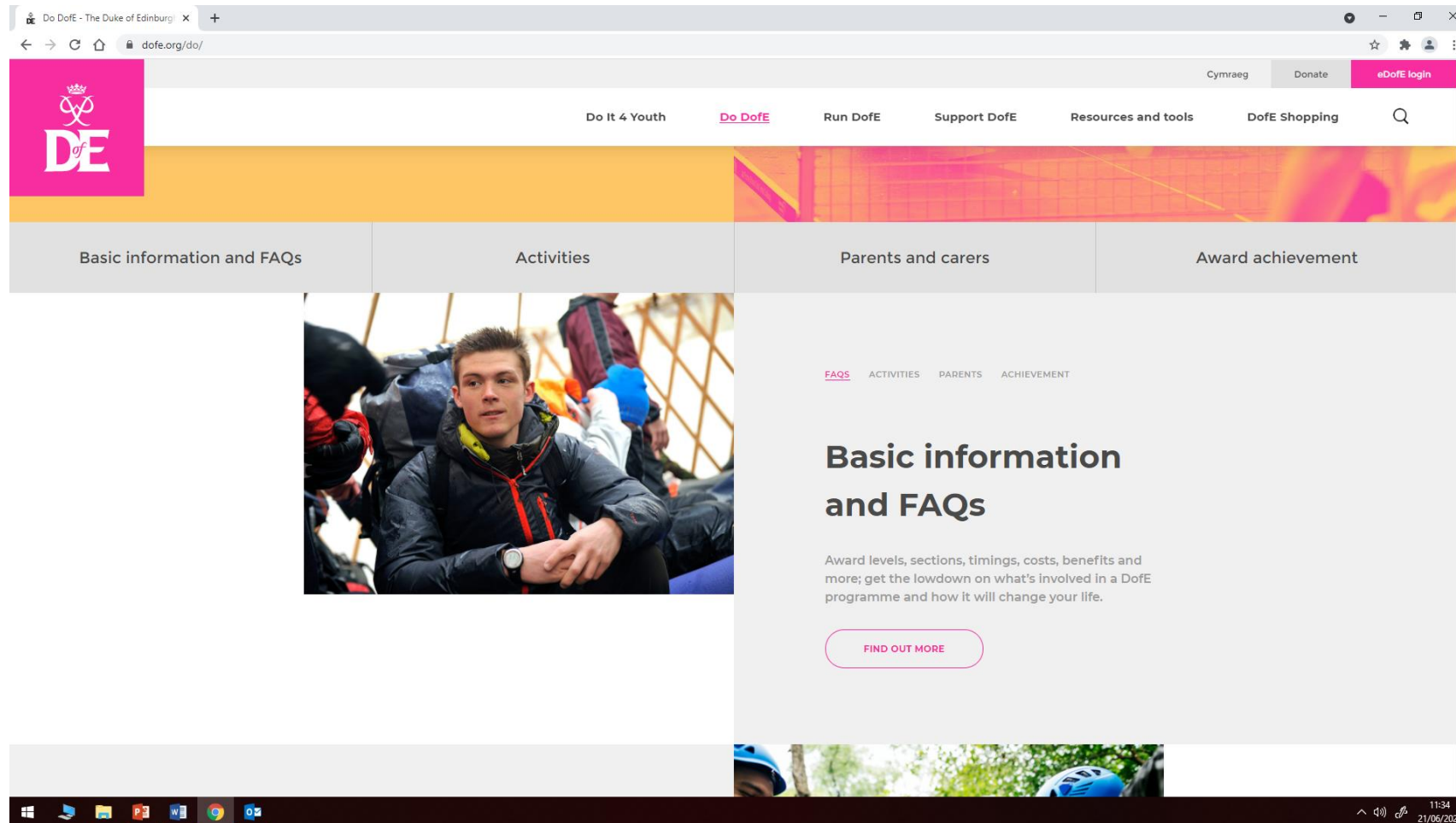
