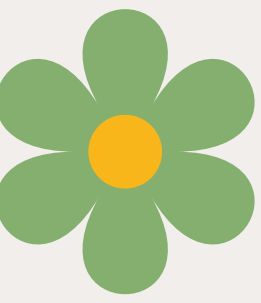
What was the book about?

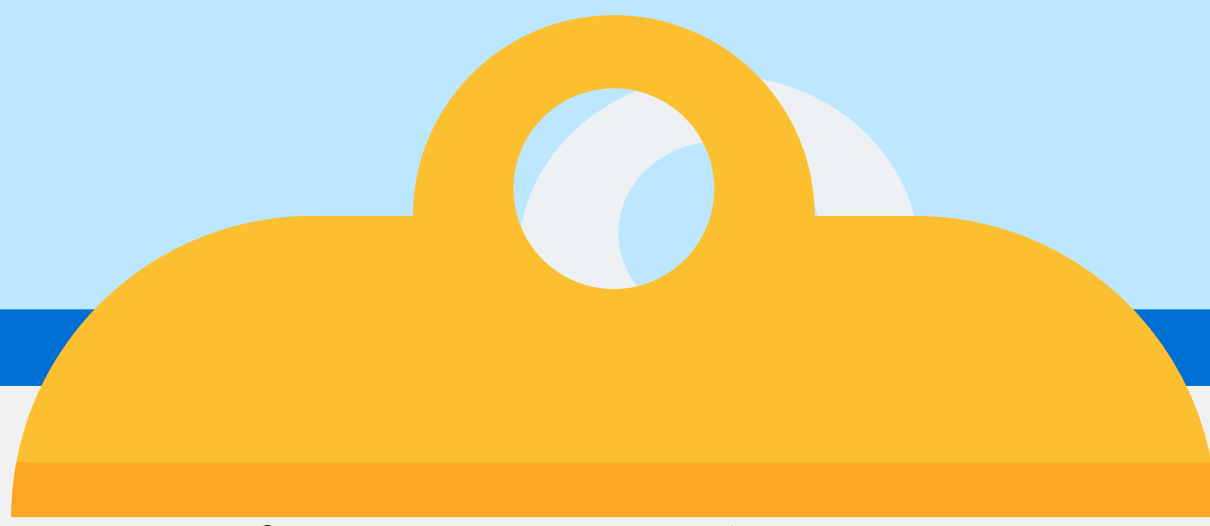
